I duly received your letter of the 24th instant in reference to the Formal Investigation to be held into the loss of the S.S. "RUMORE", and I note your remarks.

It is observed that Mr. Dunsmuir will attend the Enquiry, and for his guidance I enclose a draft of the suggested statement of evidence. I shall be glad if he will be good enough to forward two signed copies of his statement, in order that one copy may be forwarded to the Board of Trade, and one retained in this Office for record.

The Reports indicated on the draft statement are being sent to you under separate cover, for production at the Court, if required, and I have to request that you will arrange for any correspondence attached to these Reports to be detached before they are produced.

The First Entry Report and plans of the vessel are also being sent, under separate cover, for Mr. Dunsmuir's guidance, though it is probable that these will not require to be produced in Court. He should be in possession of a Volume of the Society's 1919-1920 Rules, and the correspondence is being again forwarded to you, as desired.
