IT IS SUBMITTED the Glasgow Office be advised that it is noted that Mr. Dunsmuir will attend the Inquiry into the loss of the above steamer.

A draft of the suggested statement of evidence should be sent for his guidance, and he should forward two signed copies to this Office, one for record and the other for submission to the Board of Trade. The reports indicated on the draft statement should be forwarded to the Glasgow Office for production at the Court, if required, and any correspondence attached to these reports should be detached before they are produced.

The First Entry Report and plans should also be sent for Mr. Dunsmuir's guidance, though it is probable that these will not require to be produced in court. He should be in possession of a Volume of the Society's 1919-1920 Rules, and the correspondence should be returned to the Glasgow Office.

Mr. Dunsmuir should be requested to forward a ~~full~~ report of the proceedings and of the findings of the Court.

The Solicitor's Department of the Board of Trade should be advised that Mr. R. Dunsmuir, a Senior Surveyor from the Glasgow Office, will represent the Society at the Inquiry.
