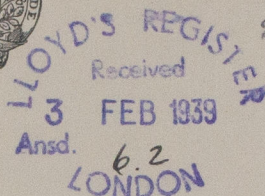

S.S. "RUMORE."

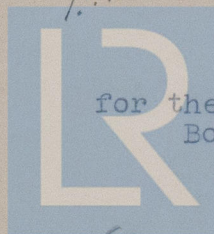
I have your letter of the 1st instant, the contents of which is noted.


