

Enquiry into the loss of the S.S. "RUMORE"

---

This matter is fully stated in the endorsement dated 4.8.38 and memorandum dated 5.8.38.

An official letter has now been received from the Board of Trade in which they request that facilities be afforded to their Mr. Green to investigate the reports and plans of this ship, and they would prefer that these documents should be seen in Glasgow, but if inconvenient to the Society they would instruct Mr. Green to attend the London Office for this purpose.

It is noted that no reference is made in the Board's letter to the "RUBAAN" and "KYLE RHEA", sister vessels to the "RUMORE" which formed the subject of Dr. Webster's communication dated 2nd August. It is considered, therefore, that no objection need be taken to the plans and reports for the "RUMORE" being forwarded to the Society's Glasgow Office for exhibition to Mr. Green, and it is submitted this be done.
