RENEWALS AND REPAIRS:

18 Hatch wood covers renewed also hatch cleats as necessary.
 Rest bars on 4 wheels failed.
 New locks fitted on all casing doors.
 Bent coaming to hold, fwd. end, renewed.
 New wood plugs and canvas covers supplied for all vent coamings.
 New wood plugs supplied for all air pipes.
 Rails and stanchions on D.C. all removed, failed replaced.
 A few minor repairs effected.
