Reverting to our letter of 22nd instant forwarding Trieste Report No. 8515 giving particulars for the assignment of freeboards to the M.V. "INFANTE DON JAIME", Messrs. Cantiere Navale Triestino's Yard No. 206, we have to acknowledge the receipt of your telegraphic assignment, as follows:-

INFANTE DON JAIME = Vessel's name

GWOIMGWUKS = The freeboard assigned is 9 ft 4½ ins from top of statutory deck line to centre of disc.

GYAWT = The statutory deck line is 1" above the wood deck at side.

The other lines should be marked as follows:-

GYDUL = Fresh Water 5" above centre of disc.

GYEPF = Indian Summer 3½" above centre of disc.

GYFWE = Winter 3½" below centre of disc.

GYKOR = Compulsory freeboard.
