We are again writing to Mr. Pittaluga to-day and should an answer be received by us we shall inform you forthwith.

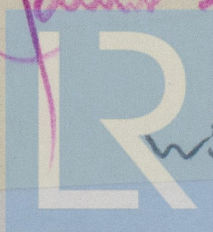
