 Details of particulars of Casualty This vessel is reported to have been swept away from her moorings on the 13th January, 1939, owing to the River Douro being in flood, and to have been carried over the bar on to a sandbank, where she remains in an exposed position.

A salvage vessel arrived to examine the possibility of salvage, but no further information has come to hand.

In reply to the special casualty notice, the Owners state that in view of the place of stranding, they consider there is no hope of salvage. Their insurers, however, have requested them to wait for two months, as from the 9th February, before a final decision has been reached.

No further reports have been published respecting this case, and no reply has been received to another letter addressed to the Owners on the 3rd instant.

 CRAFT BROKEN ADRIFF IN RIVER DOURO  
 Oporto, Jan. 18. — Rockbreakers BELIER and CAPRICORNE, bucket dredge VERSEAU, and pontoon crane CHEVRE, all owned by Societe Anonyme Entreprise Ossude, neg. swept away from moorings by strong current owing to flood on River Douro and carried over bar out to sea. CHEVRE sank and disappeared at entrance to river; both rockbreakers driven ashore on sandbank about half-mile south of entrance, where they remain in a very exposed position. VERSEAU drifting helplessly about two miles south of River Douro about two miles off shore. Lloyd's Agent.

 THE CRAFT BROKEN ADRIFF IN RIVER DOURO  
 Oporto, Jan. 19. — Societe Anonyme Entreprise Ossude, neg. previously reported. Rockbreakers CAPRICORNE stranded on edge of sandbank outside entrance to the river, heading S.E., listed seaward. Rockbreaker BELIER, at high water, sunk in about 20 ft. of water lies in an upright position 1 mile S. of entrance to the river, and off shore. Bucket dredge VERSEAU disappeared.
