I am in receipt of your letter of the 24th instant, forwarding communications from Messrs. Lobnitz & Co., Ltd. and Mr. Sutherst, having reference to Glasgow Report No.58156 on the Non-propelled Rock Cutter "CAPRICORNE" (Messrs. Lobnitz & Co's Yard No.994), and the Firm's remarks regarding the safety valves for the donkey boiler have been noted.

This case has to-day received consideration, and, in all the circumstances, and in view of the fact that the accumulation tests were satisfactory and that the Owners of the vessel acquiesce, the safety valves of $2\frac{1}{2}$ " diameter will be accepted.

The Reports on the boiler are returned herewith for the necessary alterations regarding General Remarks.
