This vessel has been dry docked for the purpose of cleaning & painting and also for inspection of bottom after grounding which occurred on one of the Gunderke trials. found One plate in flat of bottom B Strake on SB in No. 2 tank slightly indented & some rivets started, same fair red in place and started rivets renewed. Tank No. 2 tested under hydraulic pressure with satisfactory results. Bottom now in good Condition scraped, cleaned and treated. Moulder & fastenings of Seaconnections good. Freeboard marks verified & found correct.
