The *1st* S.S. No. 2 has also been ~~held~~ *completed.* and following repairs done due to wear and tear:-

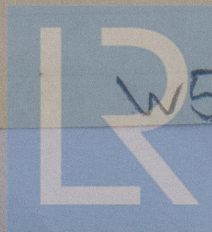
It is submitted the vessel is worthy to remain classed with record of Survey *7.24 Ans.* and notation of *S.S. Ans. No. 2-23* as recommended.
