## OVERDUE VESSEL

LYSAKER III.—Oslo, Mar. 9.—It is feared that the Norwegian steamer Lysaker III, which left Rekefjord on Feb. 28 for Rotterdam, has been lost with her crew of 16.—Reuter.

London, Mar. 9.—In reply to inquiry, the owners of the steamer Lysaker III, cable from Oslo to-day as follows: Lysaker III left Rekefjord Feb. 28 for Rotterdam, sorry no later information.

London, Mar. 9.—In reply to inquiry, Lloyd's Agents at Rotterdam cable to-day as follows: Norwegian steamer Lysaker III, has not arrived, we have no info.

LYSAKER III.—Wick Wireless Station, Mar. 12.—Following intercepted in Norwegian from Finnish (? Danish) steamer Finland to Flekkeroy Radio at 2 22 p.m., G.M.T., to-day: Steamer Finland reports Mar. 12, at 2 p.m., G.M.T., passed upturned empty lifeboat with name "Lysaker, Hjemmeløst" (belonging to), Oslo. Have been unable to communicate with steamer Finland or Flekkeroy Radio. (Note.—The Lysaker III left Rekefjord on Feb. 28 for Rotterdam.)

Wick Wireless Station, Mar. 12.—Re interception from Finnish (? Danish) steamer Finland: Position now reported as lat. 57° 6' N., long. 2° 40' E. (Note.—The Danish steamer Finland left Copenhagen on Mar. 11 for Methil.)

LYSAKER III.—Danzig, Mar. 11.—Danish steamer Skagerak arrived at Gdynia on Mar. 19 and reports having passed lifeboat Lysaker III half under water, no men, in lat. 56° 43' N., long. 2° 29' E., on Mar. 13, 8 a.m., on the voyage from United Kingdom for Aalborg. (Note.—The Lysaker III left Rekefjord on Feb. 28 for Rotterdam.)

LYSAKER III.—London, Apr. 6.—In reply to inquiry with reference to the Norwegian steamer Lysaker III, which left Rekefjord on Feb. 28 for Rotterdam, and of which a lifeboat was passed on Mar. 13, Lloyd's Agent at Oslo writes, under date of Apr. 2: No further news. Maritime investigation to be held here shortly. Owners presume vessel lost.

LYSAKER III.—London, June 10.—In reply to inquiry with reference to the steamer Lysaker III, Lloyd's Agent at Oslo writes under date of June 9: I have communicated with the owner, Mr. Ludvig Lorentzen, of Lysaker, of the steamer Lysaker III. No news has been obtained from this vessel since she left Rekefjord on Feb. 28 for Rotterdam.

## UNTRACED VESSELS

London, July 1.—In consequence of no information having been received in the following vessels since the dates given, closing entries have been made to-day against their names in Lloyd's Records:

Lysaker III, steamer, of Oslo, 1167 tons gross, which left Rekefjord on Feb. 28, 1936, for Rotterdam.

This vessel left Rekefjord on the 28th February, 1936, bound for Rotterdam, & nothing further has been heard of her.

An empty lifeboat marked "Lysaker III" was sighted in lat. 56.53N., long. 2.29E., on the 13th March.

The vessel was posted at Lloyd's as missing on the 1st July.

A casualty notice was sent to the Owner on the 1st July, but no reply has been received.
