We beg to acquaint you that we have today forwarded you under separate cover the freeboard verification form together with the report and computation for the above vessel and we shall be glad if you will forward us a copy of the report and two copies of the computation under the ¹⁹⁰⁹ ~~1906~~ Rules. *(See Oslo letter 16/4/34)*

The vessel is now in a condition to satisfy the Norwegian

Authorities the following alterations having been carried out:-

1. Wood plugs and canvas covers are supplied for closing the ventilators.
2. Wood plugs are fitted for closing the air pipes.
3. The scuppers and Sanitary discharges from the bridge space fitted with wood plugs and flapvalves respectively.
4. The lower length of pipe of the W.C. from the bridge space is of steel.
5. The covers on all hatchways are in good condition.

The certificates have been handed over to the Bergen Surveyor to have the dates filled in when the Special Survey is completed, and we shall inform you as soon as we are informed accordingly.
