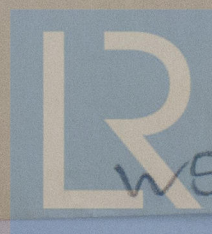
In the circumstances I shall be obliged if you will kindly inform me which freeboards have been marked and if necessary forward an amended marking form.
