Charles Adamson MILLAR will say :-

I am a Senior Ship Surveyor to Lloyd's Register of Shipping. I surveyed the S.S. "VARDULIA" at Hartlepool on the 10th October, 1935, and I produce my Report No. 17502.

I recommended that the vessel be continued as classed without fresh record, subject to the damaged bulwark plates etc. on starboard side being repaired at Owners' convenience and also as per S.R.L. S.R.L. means Special Reasons List which deals with matters which need special examination at subsequent surveys.

Apart from this explanation, there is nothing else to say about my Report except that it contains the views which I formed as the result of my careful survey of the ship.
