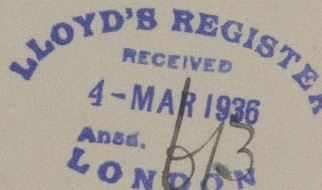

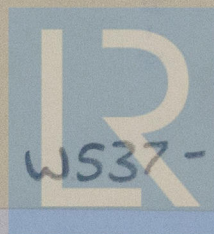
Thank you for your letter of yesterday's date.
