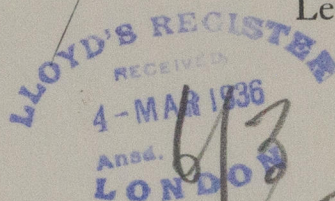

In the event of both Surveyors having to attend the same day, we shall be pleased to learn if assistance could be given to carry out the work in this port during their absence.

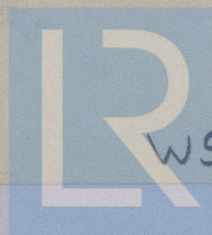
