Will you please be good enough to let me have these as soon as possible.

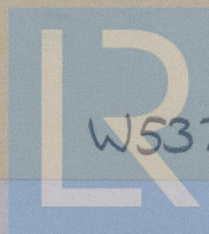
Copies of the Midship Section and Steel Plans would also be helpful if you are in a position to supply them.
