Reverting to Mr. Bennett's letter of the 8th instant enclosing one from Messrs. Russell & Co. in which it is stated that the Owners (Messrs. Gow Harrison & Co. as given in Mr. Bennett's letter of the 13th instant) of their No.691 (s.s."VERDUN") desire to have five watertight bulkheads extending to the upper deck and one watertight bulkhead extending to the second deck, I have to say that suitable compensation for the omission of the bulkhead in question having been arranged for, the Owners' request is approved, subject to the following notation being made in the Register Book on the completion of the vessel, namely:-

"1 Intermediate B.H. and 1 'tween deck B.H. dispensed with, 5 B.H. to upper deck, 1 B.H. to second deck only".
