STEEL SCREW STEAMER "VERDUN", Messrs. Russell & Co's
No. 691, building with a view to class 100A1.

Rule dimensions: 422.5 x 55.88 x 31.31

This vessel is of a length to require seven watertight bulkheads to be fitted.

The Builders proposal to fit five watertight bulkheads extending to the upper deck, and one watertight bulkhead to the Second deck only, was approved by the General Committee at their meeting on the 16th December 1914, subject to a letter being received from the actual Owners desiring the omission of the Bulkhead in question.

Suitable compensation for the omission of the bulkheads in the form of deep web frames was proposed and approved at the same time.

A letter has now been received from the Greenock Surveyors enclosing one from the Builders, in which it is stated that the Owners, Messrs. Gow, Harrison & Co., have written to Messrs. Russell & Co. as follows:-


"Please note that in order to suit our Cargo & Trading arrangements we wish the above vessel to have five watertight bulkheads extending to the upper deck, and one watertight bulkhead extending to the Second deck".

It is submitted the proposal merits approval, subject to the following notation being made in the Register Book on the completion of the vessel - "1 intermediate B. H. and 1 'tween deck B.H. dispensed with, 5 B. H. to upper deck, 1 B. H. to second deck only".
