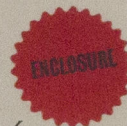

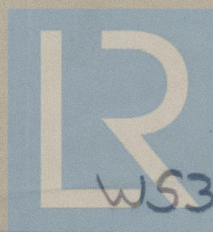
S.S. "Lucellum" No: 642.
