Dear Sir,

I have to acquaint you I am in receipt of a report from the Society's Surveyor at Fregantle from which it appears that the steamer "MINDEROO" has been examined as far as practicable afloat and extensive damage was found to the shell plating, framing, floors &c., in way of Nos. 4 & 5 double bottom tanks and to the shell plating in No. 3 hold through resting on a sand bank. Temporary repairs were effected and, in the Surveyor's opinion, the vessel is fit to be towed to port of repairs and he recommends permanent repairs be carried out at the earliest opportunity.

It appears that the vessel is to be towed to Singapore, and, in the circumstances, I shall be glad if you will give the case attention.
