Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 1st instant addressed to Mr. Watt, a Principal Surveyor on the Chief Ship Surveyor's Staff, respecting the Steamers "RIP", "SUZON" and "VAE VICTIS", and note that you have been requested to survey these vessels with a view to the assignment of freeboards under the International Convention.

With regard thereto I send herewith an extract of particulars taken from the previous freeboard report in each case, and have to request that you will forward the full particulars required on form C11.

In this connexion I have to request that you will be guided by the Extracts from the Board of Trade's Draft Rules already in your possession.

I also enclose a copy of a C11 Report for your guidance, and you should see that full information regarding the present condition of these ships is reported.


At the same time I have to request that you will forward a copy of the displacement scale for each ship.
