Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 2nd instant losing one from the Owner respecting the fee charged you for the verification of the freeboard markings of S.S. "RIP" ex "ST. AGNES", and I shall be glad if you will inform the Owner in reply that when the name of a vessel has changed a fresh freeboard certificate bearing the new name of the ship is required, in order to clear her. For the issue of this certificate it is necessary for the Society's Surveyors to check the marks on the vessel's sides and report the facts to this Office, and for such service the minimum fee is £1:1:0.

For your information I think it well to state that the above service is rendered concurrently with another survey for which a fee is being charged, no fee should be charged for the freeboard survey.
