

Screw steamer No.123 proposed to be built by the
Island Shipbuilding Co., with a view to class 100A1
"With freeboard", "Arch Deck".

Dimensions: 283.5 x 40.33 x 25.42 moulded depth including
a 6'-0" arch.

Plans of midship section and profile (in duplicate)
submitted by the Builders through the Glasgow Office.

The vessel is similar in type, although larger than
S.S. Swan Hunter & Wigham Richardson's S.S. No. 1201, plans for
vessel have recently been approved.

Mr. Ayre, representing the Builders, called at this
Office on November 20th and discussed certain of the scantlings
of the vessel to be built by his firm, and these have now been
approved in the proposals.

The plans have been examined in this Office and it
is submitted that provided

the vessel will be worthy to be classed 100A1 "With freeboard"
with the special notation "Arch deck".

The Builders should be
requested to forward the lines plan
and displacement sections, together
with the particulars of tonnage,
and other particulars, in order that
the provisional freeboards may be
determined.
