



The 2nd S.S.No.3 became due 2,35 and no part of the survey has been held. The vessel has been laid up in the Tyne and the usual undertaking furnished.

In reply to enquiry the Newcastle Surveyors state they are informed by Messrs. Hughes Bolckow Shipbreaking Co. that they have purchased the vessel for demolition, and are expecting to remove her from the Tyne to their Yard in Blyth in the course of a week or so.
