H. With reference to my letter of the 3rd June last relative to the steamer "SPILSBY", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have today had this case under their consideration in view of the fact that the year of grace allowed for the 2nd Special Survey No.3 has now expired. It would appear from a communication which has been received from the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle that this vessel is still laid up in the Tyne, and I would explain that in such cases it is the Committee's usual practice to require Owners to furnish an undertaking to carry out all overdue surveys before the vessel again goes into commission. The Committee conclude you will have no objection to doing so in this instance, and I enclose a printed form of undertaking which I shall be glad if you will kindly sign and return to this Office in due course. A duplicate copy of the form is also enclosed for your filing purposes.
