"SPILSBY" to proceed to Italy to be broken up, without a general examination, and with regard to the Boiler Survey referred to in the last paragraph of your letter, I very much regret to find that the remarks contained in my letter of the 3rd instant related to another case altogether, and through an error were inadvertently included in the letter in question.

As you rightly point out, the Boiler Survey of the "SPILSBY" only became due last month, and the Committee will not require this survey to be carried out if the vessel is to proceed to Italy within a reasonably short time.

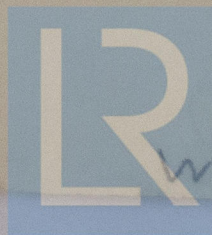
