Dear Sir,

R. Acting upon the suggestion of Messrs. Arcos, Ltd., of this city, I am directed to request your assistance in regard to the vessels mentioned on the accompanying list, all of which have at various times been severely damaged through stranding.

In each instance, it has been reported that salvage operations have been undertaken by the Soviet Authorities, but it has not been possible subsequently to ascertain the ultimate fate of these vessels.

In the circumstances, I shall esteem it a favour if you will kindly let me know whether they have been salvaged and placed in commission, or abandoned as total losses by all concerned.

Should any of these vessels have been recovered, repaired and are now sailing, I shall be glad to receive any particulars you may care to afford regarding changes of name, ownership, &c.

I may say that this information is required for the purposes of the Society's Register Book.
