In B.	Vessel's Name	Tons Gross	Remarks.
51	<u>ALKAID</u>	4441	Seriously damaged through stranding at Cape Orlov on 30th July, 1933. Refloated and beached at Gorolesko Bay. Again refloated on 15th September, 1933, and taken to Archangel.
40	HAUGLAND	3153	Stranded on Soviet Coast on 13th October, 1933. Reported to have been salvaged and towed to Poljarnaia, Kola Bay. Taken over by Soviet Authorities.
07	PYTHEAS	3028	Stranded near Eupatoria Point on 9th February, 1932. Refloated on 24th March, 1932, and towed to Odessa.
46	Sculcoates (Trawler)	337	Stranded at Kildin Island, off Murman Coast, on 10th March, 1934. Owners abandoned vessel as a total loss. Soviet Authorities attempting salvage.
