the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners' Representative attend on board of the Dutch steel screw steamer "ALKAID", 4441 tons gross, of Rotterdam, whilst lying afloat at this port in order to witness the testing of the derricks for all hatchways, together with all gear attached such as blocks, shackles, links, topping lifts and pendants, also all permanent attachments in accordance therewith such as smithwork, eyeplates, masthoops, etc. and that 10 derricks on 2 masts and 2 derrickposts withstood a statical load of 4,5 tons.

The test was carried out on the 21st of July 1933.

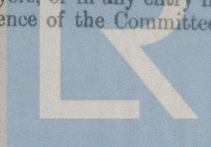
