Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 27th ultimo, with reference to the date of build of the s.s. "TENBERGEN", and note your remarks concerning the first entry certificate.

In the circumstances it is considered that you should inform the owners of the Committee's decision as regards the date of build, and with reference to their enquiry whether a new first entry certificate will be issued, you should explain that, in accordance with the Committee's invariable practice, the first entry certificates originally issued for the vessel were supplied to the Builders who usually hand them to the owners on completion of the contract.

If the original certificate be returned to this office, the date of build thereon will be amended, or a fresh certificate issued in lieu, as may be more satisfactory.
