S.S. "TENBERGEN".

This vessel, recently built by the N.V.Lobithsche Scheepsbouw Maatschappij for the Furness Shipping & Agency Co., was launched on the 30th July 1921, and in accordance with the Rule then in force her date of build was recorded in the Register Book as 1,22.

The Rotterdam Surveyors now forward a letter from the Owners pointing out that the ship was not completed until September 1922, and requesting that the date of build may be altered to that month.

The Rotterdam Surveyors confirm the statement that the vessel was not completed until September 1922, and the last date of survey entered on their First Entry Reports is 9.9.22. They add that, as the vessel in the meantime had been lying in fresh water and was thoroughly examined before the reports were made, they recommend the Owners' request for favourable consideration.

The Society's present Rule on the subject (Paragraph 7 of the General Regulations) is:-

"The date of completion of the Special Survey
"of vessels built under the Society's inspection
"will be taken as the date of build."

It is submitted for the favourable consideration of the Committee that the date of build of this vessel should be altered to September 1922.
