I have to acquaint you that the Owners of the steamer "OROYA" at present laid up in the River Dart, have decided to place this vessel into commission.

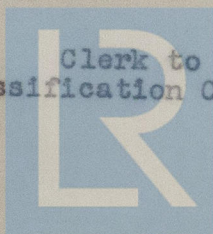
