I am to inform you, with reference to my letter of the ^{January last} 2nd ultmo, that in accordance with the owner's practise of lettering the decks of their vessels, the middle deck which is the deck next below the bulkhead deck in this vessel, is to be lettered "A" and the bulkhead deck will be "B" deck.

I shall be glad if you will let me know in due course, the position of the centre of disc relative to the subdivision load lines, in order that the necessary endorsement for the freeboard certificates may be communicated.
