REPAIRS ~~TO ENGINES AND BOILERS~~ DUE TO DAMAGE THROUGH GROUNDING.


The class is subject to the impeller casing of the circulating pump being renewed on arrival at Amsterdam.

Repairs:- Screw shaft found cracked at both ends of liner- new shaft now fitted.

Some condenser tubes renewed and the condenser tested.

A new impeller casing for the circulating pump now fitted.

It is submitted the vessel is eligible to remain as classed with fresh record of survey S(N) 3,38, without special conditions.
