Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your classing letter of the 19th instant and in regard to the First Entry on the Steamer "**Domeric**" I beg to state that the butts of the bottom plating (from Keel to upper turn of bilge ) were treble riveted as given in the report .

This complies with the requirements of the rules for the thickness of bottom plating and was accepted for Messrs. J.L. Thompson & Sons S.S. "**WAR OPAL**" Sunderland report No.27388 and since that time has been adopted in Messrs. Doxford's "F" type vessels.

The riveting should have been amended on the midship section as fitted and I regret that this was not done.
