Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your classing letter of the 19th instant and in regard to the First Entry on the Steamer "Domeric" I beg to state that the butts of the bottom plating (from Keel to upper turn of bilge) were treble riveted as given in the report .

This complies with the requirements of the rules for the thickness of bottom plating and was accepted for Messrs. J.L. Thompson & Sons S.S. "WAR OPAL" Sunderland report No.27388 and since that time has been adopted in Messrs. Doxford's "F" type vessels.

The riveting should have been amended on the midship section as fitted and I regret that this was not done.
