Précis of particulars of Casualty

This vessel, when she was the

"ESSEX MANOR", ran ashore on rocks at Erimosaki, Japan, on the 1st August, 1937, and sustained very extensive damage.

She was refloated, towed to Yokohama, and after survey, was declared a Constructive Total Loss and sold.

In all the circumstances the Committee decided in January this year to expunge the vessel's class with the record "Stranded 8,37 - In port damaged".

The Yokohama Surveyors now state that the vessel has been repaired and replaced in commission.

In accordance with the standing instructions, the case is again submitted to the Committee in order that the standing record may be altered to "Stranded 8,37 - refloated. Now trading".
