In accordance with the instructions contained in the London letter of the 22nd Insth respecting the equipment proposed for the Fairfield S. B. Co. J. S/s N^o 424, I have consulted with the Builders and the owners representative, and now enclose a further proposal of the Builders for the equipment of bower anchors as follows:-

2 Bower anchors 11 7/2 cwt. Stockless
 2. " " 72 " (ex stock) Rodgers.
 Stream and Kedge anchors ^{90 with stock} as before.

This arrangement of bower anchors is similar to that approved for the J. S/s "Kildonan Castle" & "Kinfauns Castle".

The approved Midship Section was forwarded with my letter of the 23rd Insth for reference in dealing with the plan of stem frame &c.
