Dear Sirs,

I duly received Dr. Webster's letter of the 6th July respecting the Kawasaki Dockyard Co's Nos. 506-7-8, and his remarks have been noted.

In reply I have to state that the bottom plating may be reduced as per Section 16, Paragraph 15 of the Rules, and in the present instance the proposal to reduce the bottom plating in way of double bottom .04" could be approved for a freeboard corresponding to a moulded draft of 28.21 feet.

I have therefore cabled you accordingly, as desired, as follows, viz:-

"KAWASAKI 506/7/8 bottom plating in way double bottom
"reduced point noughtfour with moulded draft twentyeight
"point twentyone feet."

Your account has been debited with £1.16.8, the cost of the above cablegram, and I shall be glad if you will collect this amount from the Builders.
