UPON EXAMINATION FOUND.

One blade sharply indented on
leading edge for 2" over area
of 4"x12". Wheel tip more or
less bent on edges. One blade
bent aft on leading tip about
4" overall area approximately
4"x18". No evidence of cracks.
Nuts, cement, etc., all intact.

RECOMMENDED:

Blades to be faired when vessel
next on drydeck.

NOTE - Vessel is loading gasoline for New York, and will
make one more voyage and drydeck at Baltimore
about June 24, 1938.
