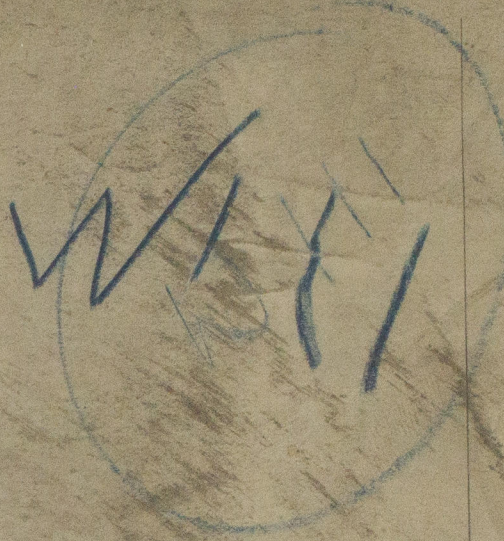

The 1st Special Survey No. 3 became due in June, 1933, & as a result of a modified survey held at Rotterdam in June last, the class was allowed to remain undisturbed until the end of February, 1935.

A letter, dated 2nd March, has now been received from the Owners stating that the vessel has been sold for breaking up & was handed over to the new Owners on the 29th February.

According to Lloyd's Index the vessel arrived at Osaka on the 24th February - sold Japan - to be broken up.
