In the event of the vessel arriving in your district I shall be glad if you will kindly inform me immediately the work of demolition is commenced.

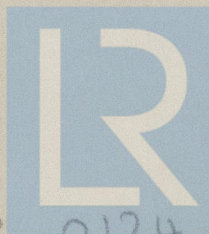
