The 2nd S.S.No.1 became due 7,33.

The vessel being laid up in the Tyne since May 1931 the Owners have furnished the usual undertaking.

In April last a proposal to allow the vessel to proceed to a port abroad, probably Greek, with cargo was agreed to provided the vessel be generally examined in accordance with Circular No.1605, including Boiler and Tailshaft surveys, and satisfactorily reported upon.

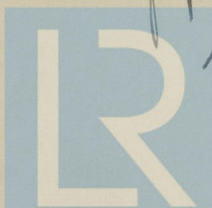
In reply to enquiry the Newcastle Surveyors state the ship is still laid up.

It is submitted for consideration whether in view of the Special Survey being now more than two years overdue the Owners should be asked to arrange for the ship to be generally examined.
