The class is subject to some boiler repairs being carried out before the vessel is again placed in commission.

The vessel has been laid up in the Tyne since May 1931, and the usual undertaking has been furnished

A letter has been received from the Newcastle Surveyors enclosing one from the Owners desiring to know on what conditions the Committee would agree, in the event of sale to foreign buyers, to a certificate being issued to allow the ship to proceed with cargo to a foreign port, the overdue Special Survey to be carried out by the buyers on arrival at that port. The Surveyors understand that negotiations are in progress with a Greek firm, and that if the sale is completed the survey would be carried out at a Greek port.

The vessel was last examined in dry dock in January 1931.

The year of grace expired 7,34.

The case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
