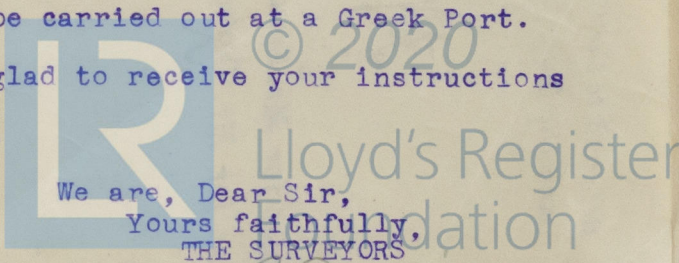
We might add, we understand that the negotiations are proceeding with a Greek Firm and that should the sale be completed the survey would be carried out at a Greek Port.
