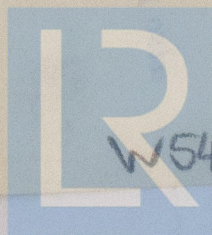
The understanding is that on arrival in the Far East, the cylindrical tanks would be removed and the vessel reconstructed and put through a special survey as a cargo carrier.
