


S.S. "GLITRA".

Mr. Douglas, of Messrs. Douglas & Ramsey, called at this Office to-day to renew his application to the Committee for permission to trade the above vessel for a short time, pending the delivery of his new vessels.

He stated that he was quite sure the Committee would appreciate his position as a Shipowner ^{his} in anxiety to participate in the present rise of freights.

He was convinced that examination of the "GLITRA" would show that she was a well-found ship and added that on his part he would be prepared to submit her to any modified form of Special Survey including dry docking and boiler survey, that the Committee might require before granting any extension of time for trading purposes prior to breaking up.

As regards employment, he would willingly accept any restriction placed by the Committee as to freight or voyage, but would naturally prefer, from her size, to trade from the Mediterranean.
