Précis of particulars of Casualty

This vessel is reported to have stranded near Horomushiro Island, Chishima Archipelago on the 11th May.

Salvage operations were attempted, but during a typhoon which swept over Chushima at the end of July, it is stated that the vessel broke into three parts & became a total loss.

A casualty notice was sent to the Owners on the 6th October, but no reply has been received.
